



#### Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord - Sunday, March 24, 2024





This week, we have officially entered into the holiest week of the year. It seems as though the past couple of years have been hectic and unpredictable with these celebrations. Therefore, I thought it would be good to review our upcoming Holy Week celebrations, letting you know what practices we will be utilizing in our celebrations this year.

Holy Thursday (7:00 p.m.) – Holy Thursday celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood. One unique aspect of this celebration is the washing of the feet. In addition, Holy Thursday ends with a Eucharistic procession throughout the church, ending with the Blessed Sacrament being taken to the Adoration Chapel. The Adoration Chapel will remain open until 11:00 p.m., when Jesus in the Eucharist will be placed in the tabernacle until we celebrate His Resurrection at Easter.

Good Friday (3:00 p.m., 6:30 p.m. Spanish) – On Good Friday, we recall the crucifixion and death of Jesus. During this service, there is customarily a veneration of the Cross. There are actually a number of options for veneration, including a genuflection, bow, a touching of the Cross with your hand, or kissing the Cross. Of course, anyone who prefers to venerate the Cross by remaining kneeling in the pew is free to do so as well.

Easter Vigil (8:30 p.m.) – This is the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord! Although this is a significantly longer Mass, there is none as unique as this Mass throughout the entire year. It is really something to experience! During this ceremony, we will be bringing a new member into the Church as well. Please come to support the new member of our Church, as well as to celebrate the greatest celebration of the year!

Easter Day (8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m. Spanish) – We continue to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. Please note that there will be no 5:00 p.m. Confessions or 6:00 p.m. Mass on this day. Be sure to come to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

#### **Catechesis of the Good Shephard**

Now that we have presented the various places in the City of Jerusalem, one particular place we focus on with the children is the Cenacle, or the Upper Room. As we well know, the Last Supper is foundational to the Paschal Mystery, to the mystery of Christ Himself, as well as to the mystery of the Eucharistic presence. Therefore, because it is among the greatest mysteries of our faith, it should be offered to young children. Yet, the question is how? How do we remain at the level of essentiality with children as young as three? Again, we follow the rule of beginning with only the most essential announcement and allowing the truth to expand as the child grows.

Sofia Cavalletti, a founding catechist of the CGS method, writes: Initially, our focus is simply on this particular moment in Jesus' life, just before he died and rose. What did he do? What did he say in that upstairs room in the Cenacle? We introduce the reading of the text by acknowledging the liturgical time of Lent that we are in, preparing to celebrate the greatest feast when Jesus died and was risen. Just before that happened, Jesus had come once again to Jerusalem. It was the Jewish feast of Passover, which included a special meal with one's family. Jesus wanted to celebrate that feast with those most like family to him: his disciples, and so he chose a special place and sent two of his disciples there to get things ready for the Passover meal.

The materials are a wooden box representing the Cenacle, a long wooden table covered by a white cloth, three-dimensional figures of Jesus and 12 apostles, a small paten holding a clay model of bread, and a small chalice. Each item is put in place slowly at the right time in the narrative. Great emphasis is placed on Jesus' simple words: "Take and eat. This is my body." "Take and drink.
