Divine Mercy

This Sunday, we celebrate the 2nd Sunday of Easter, which is also Divine Mercy Sunday. This devotion comes through appearances of Jesus to Saint Faustina in the early 20th century in Poland.

I must admit, I did not come upon this devotion until I started college in 2000. However, I was immediately drawn to it for 2 reasons. First, because it only takes approximately 7 minutes to pray (not the holiest of reasons, but hey – I was a young college student!). Secondly, though, I found the prayers to be simple, easy to remember, and quite profound, as our world and even our own individual lives are always in need of the great mercy of Jesus Christ.

Therefore, I would like to encourage everyone to take part in this devotion. The prayers are quite moving; the more one meditates on these prayers, the more powerful they will be. Let us always continue to seek the great mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Also, if you are available, please come to the Divine Mercy Holy Hour, this year at St. Joseph's Parish, beginning at 3:00 p.m. Confessions will be offered beginning at 2:00 p.m.

How to Recite the Chaplet

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. Our Father

4. Hail Mary

5. The Apostles' Creed

6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the remaining decades

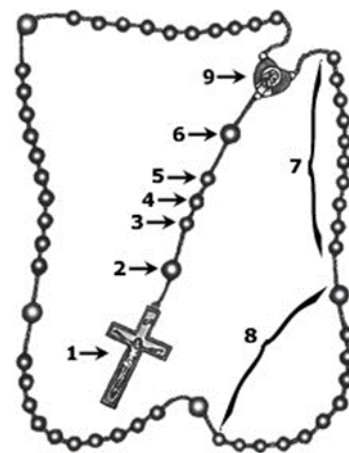
Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

10. Optional Closing Prayers

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

Catechesis of the
Good Shepherd

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

This Lent we have carried our cross. The children know Jesus as the Light who came into the world. Now is our time to celebrate the strength of the Light, the light that is stronger than the darkness. In the Gospel, early in the morning, the women approached the tomb. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid!"; a few verses later, Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid"-- words we hear so often, so we know they must be important for us! Like the women at the tomb who encountered the Risen Christ, may we go forth walking as children of the Light. We pray that the light of Christ, rising in glory, dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds. Alleluia! Alleluia!

Resurrection is such a great mystery, and the Church's celebration helps us to grasp its meaning. The Church enters the season of Easter with the Liturgy of Light at the Easter Vigil. In the atrium we do this same celebration, though modified so that the children can participate more fully at a pace that is suited to them. In our religious experience with children in the atrium, we have seen how the quality of celebration should permeate all of catechesis. The Liturgy of Light is a particularly intense moment of celebration.

What is proclaimed in the Bible is lived in the liturgy. Helping the children to experience this reality offers them an opportunity to enjoy more fully the relationship they have with God and others. This is especially true in the Liturgy of Light. It is one of their atrium experiences that remains most vivid in the children's memories, even when they become adults. (cgsusa.org)
