

Moving Mass to the HFE Gymnasium

As many of you know, this weekend is the last weekend we will be celebrating Mass in the church before moving to the Holy Family Elementary Gymnasium so that work can officially begin in the worship space. The progress is very exciting! At the same time, it will be a period of transition as we prepare to celebrate Mass in a different space. Below are some directions that might be helpful as we move to the new space.

- Moving Items (Help Needed!) First, we will need to make sure we have everything needed for Mass. We will be moving items from the church to the gymnasium on Monday, January 29th, at 7:15 a.m. (right after daily Mass). Anyone who is able and willing to help is most welcome, and your help is most appreciated!
- Entering the School The doors that people can enter will be the west doors, the center doors on the north side (close to the school office), and the door on the southwest side (with a small flight of stairs leading directly into the gym). On weekends, the doors will be unlocked approximately 1 hour before Mass, and on weekdays, approximately 45 minutes before Mass. Also, for security purposes, at all other times the doors will remain locked. If anyone is looking for a good space for prayer outside of these times, we encourage you to use the Adoration Chapel.
- Holy Water and Missals When you enter the gymnasium, we are planning to have pedestals with bowls of holy water when you enter. Missals/hymnals will be placed on the chairs. We simply ask that you make sure to keep the missals/hymnals at their chairs as you come and go.
- Sitting, Standing, Kneeling The actual celebration of Mass will continue as usual. The only difference is that, since we will be on hard wood floors, during times for kneeling, you may either kneel or be seated as is most comfortable for you.
- Confessions We will still be able to offer Confessions at our usual times. There are rooms in the upper hallway that will be used for Confessionals. Signs will be placed outside the rooms so that you will be able to know where Confessions are held.
- Wee-words A room in the school will be provided for Wee-words at 10:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday. Hence, this ministry is able to continue.

There will be other instructions for those involved in various ministries. These will be sent via email/flocknotes, and hardcopies will be available for ministers to read when we move to the gym. Hopefully, though, this at least gives everyone enough information to begin our worship in the HFE gymnasium.

We appreciate everyone's patience during this time of transition! Please continue to pray for the success of our church projects. We look forward to the next phase of our parish! Fr. Nick Parker, Pastor

Catechesis of the Good Shephard

In December, we introduced you to the Prayer table as the center gathering space at the beginning and end of each session. Another space that is very attractive to our young parishioners is the Model Altar. This area contains a model altar and miniature items they see in the sanctuary during Mass. This is presented by inviting the children to contemplate the great feast and gift of the Eucharist at every Mass. We familiarize the child with the name, function, and meaning of the articles used at Mass, while enjoying their beauty. This prepares the children for further work in the atrium environment and fuller participation at Mass.

As parents, there are several things we can do at home to prepare our families before, during and after Mass.

- 1. Begin your preparation at home.
 - Pray as a family. Use the language and prayers that the children will hear at Mass, even if it is as simple as "Amen" or "Alleluia." With the older children, pray The Our Father; Holy, Holy, Holy; or Glory to God.
 - As you pray at home, model how to make the Sign of the Cross, how to hold your hands when at prayer, how to bow your head, how to genuflect, etc.
 - Read the Gospel aloud before you go to Church. When you speak about going to Mass, do so with joy!
- 2. Sit in the front.
 - Small children will become easily bored if they are unable to see what is happening during liturgy. Sit as close to the front as possible so that you can share with your child what is going on during liturgy.
 - Hold your little ones up so that they can see the gestures, vessels and colors.

- 3. Do not be in a hurry to leave after Mass.
- Our Churches are beautiful environments that are great opportunities to teach children about our faith. Take your child for a close-up look after Mass:
 - Statues who is depicted? Name them, "This is a statue of _____."
 - Stained Glass Windows "Who [what] do you see?" or "What colors do you see?"
 - Font "This is the font that holds holy water. We remember our baptism at the font."
 - Altar "This is the altar table on which the bread and wine are made holy."
 - Candles "The candles are placed on (or near) the altar as a sign of the light of the Risen Christ."
- This is also a great way to share with your child how to behave in Church. For example: We do not play near the candles, but we may come closer to look at the candles.


