My dear Parishioners, Easter Greetings to you all,

We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song. Easter is the feast of victory over death, victory over darkness, a feast of salvation and a commission for a mission. Jesus was raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom 1:4) and all the prediction of Jesus about his death has been fulfilled in his resurrection (Mt 12:40; Jn 2:19). It affirms that Jesus was not a mere human being, but the Messiah. We, the Christians celebrate the new life in Jesus. It gives us a hope that as Christ has been raised by God, we will be also raised and be with him in eternal life.

The empty tomb (Mk 28:8, Jn 20) was full of message and it gave St. John a hope and after seeing it, he believed in Jesus' resurrection. Many apparitions of Christ have confirmed his presence to his disciples (Jn 20-21). He had also appeared to more than five hundred people (1 Cor 15:6). Apostles said we cannot stop proclaiming what we have seen and heard (Acts 4:20). The early Christians were the messengers who carried the good news that Jesus rose from the dead and we have seen and ate with him (Jn 21:1). Thus, wherever they went they talked about the resurrection of Jesus, and they expressed their joy and happiness. All those who heard their testimony believed in Jesus. This Easter sends us all with a mission to talk about Jesus and give a testimony to the world.

Jesus approached and began traveling with two disciples of Emmaus (Mk 16:12; Lk 24:13-15) Similarly, when we are perplexed and frustrated in our life journey, Jesus comes and walks with us and gives us a new hope and horizon to launch again with the new spirit. Along with St. Paul, can we say, "I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead?" (Phil 3:10).

On Easter we truly have reason to celebrate! For out of the darkness, Christ shows his light to the world. His resurrection changes the history of salvation and gives our suffering purpose. Even when we are buried in our sorrows, we can hold onto the hope that eternal joy is coming, and God shall comfort us in our sufferings.

Easter is not just one Sunday. Easter is a way of life. It is a life where Christ is always at the center lifting us from the grave. As an "Easter people", we know what it means to rise from the grave and experience life as God has prepared for us. When life's problems come your way, lift your head up high and say, Alleluia anyhow. He is risen Alleluia. May the peace of Christ be with you all.

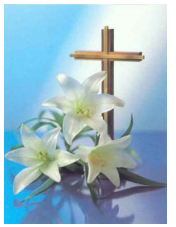
