We look forward to our final worship space before moving into the church (in September).

Coming to Mass Beginning Tuesday, May 30th

For everyone who will be coming to Mass in our church basement, in order to keep clear from work/construction, only the south doors of the church will be unlocked. Simply enter the south doors, and you may either use the stairs, or make use of our new elevator (at the end of the south hallway past the bathrooms). We plan to have greeters/ushers to help direct if needed.

Confessions in the Basement

We will be offering Confessions at our usual times in the basement – Saturdays at 3:00 p.m., Sundays at 5:00 p.m., Thursdays at 5:00 p.m., and Fridays at 12:00 p.m. Simply come to the basement. Confessions will be held in 2 of the meeting rooms on the south side. Just go to the south hallway and look for the signs that will show where to start the lines for Confessions, and look for the open meeting room doors.

However, that will arrive in a Flocknotes email sometime next week – so please be on the lookout for that. Some of the other details we will need to discover as we go as well. 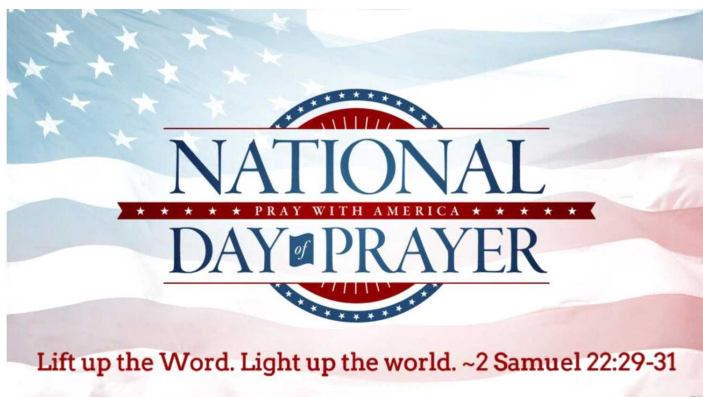

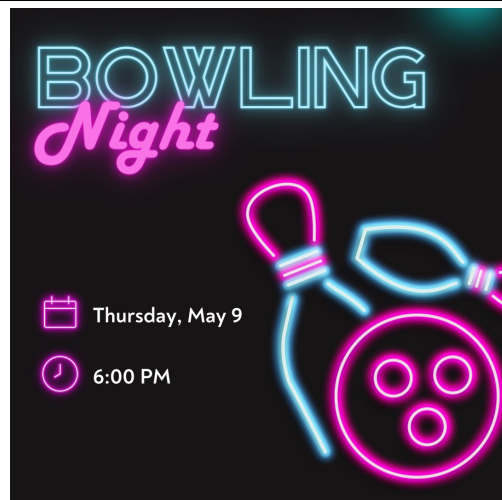


Parish Basket Raffle & Coffee and Donuts
