Presented above is the annual report for the fiscal year July 1, 2024-June 30, 2025 which has been submitted to the Diocese. The net ordinary income for IHM at the end of FY2025 was \$55,769.01. Budgeted collections were just slightly above target at 104%, several expense lines fell below the budgeted amount. Many savings were realized from the generous donations of labor and/or materials throughout the year. ***Heartland Ministries** funds tri-parish ministries such as Catholic School support, Tri Parish Faith Formation retreats, Totus Tuus, and Parish Mission retreats.
