Dear IHM Parishioners,

My name is Fr. Luke Friess. I am your new parochial vicar at the parish, and I will also be serving as chaplain at TMP. I am originally from Hoxie where I grew up with my parents and four siblings. After graduating from high school in 2012, I attended Benedictine College in Atchison, KS, where I studied mathematics and graduated in the spring of 2016. I then entered seminary formation for the Diocese of Salina that fall.

My journey through seminary was a long one filled with many unexpected twists and turns. (It even included taking two years away from seminary formation and spending most of that time living and working here in Hays!) But in the journey over the years, two desires continued recurring in my heart drawing me to the priesthood. I remember articulating one of these desires while I was living in Hays. I was praying in St. Joseph Church and realized, “This is my home.” My heart felt drawn to be a parish priest, to give my life to the Lord, and be with Him especially in the Eucharist. Around this time, another desire that welled up in my heart was the desire to be a spiritual father. My heart was attracted to accompanying people through the joys and trials of life, and hopefully in my priestly fatherhood, showing forth the face of the Heavenly Father.

Finally, after the many years of seminary formation, I was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Salina on June 12th this summer. The ordination occurred on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart which is a beautiful day for an ordination. I hope and pray that I can love the people the Lord places in my life with the love with which His Sacred Heart burns.

I am so happy the bishop assigned me to Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish. I look forward to being mentored by Fr. Nick and meeting you all. One of my greatest joys as a seminarian and now as a priest is sharing life with the people of the diocese; whether that be through prayer, faith formation, conversation, or simply visiting you and sharing a meal. I have already been praying intentionally for our parish, and I humbly ask that you pray and intercede for me as well. God bless you all!

Bishop Vincke's Message Regarding Fr. Ryan McCandless

Many of you are aware that one of our priests, Fr. Ryan McCandless, was arrested on Wednesday for indecent sexual contact with a minor. The legal system will now handle this matter through its regular channels to its end. I realize that our whole diocese, in addition to this family, is wounded and is in pain because of this very serious allegation.

To anyone who has been the victim of sexual abuse—whether by someone in the Church or elsewhere—I am deeply sorry for the pain you have endured. I am also deeply sorry for the hurt, anger, confusion and disappointment this has caused throughout our diocese.

Nothing I can say today can erase that pain. We pray for the healing of all those involved and for our diocese. Jesus knows the wounds we are carrying and wants to heal them.

What can we do? Keep our eyes on Jesus. Despite incredible trials, betrayals, and difficulties, the saints prayed to Jesus and went about doing good. We trust that where sin abounds, God's grace abounds even more. Our God desires to bring healing, hope and peace even in the most difficult moments.

Additional Message from the Salina Diocese Regarding Fr. Ryan McCandless

As you are aware, Fr. Ryan McCandless has been charged criminally with aggravated indecent liberties in Republic County. As you are also aware, Fr. Ryan previously served in this parish. Our hope is that nothing inappropriate ever occurred here with or by any clergy, including Fr. Ryan. However, I want to stress that if it did, please come forward to report the same as one may make a confidential report to the Diocese. Our Victim Assistance Coordinator is available at 866-752-8855 and you can leave a message. One can also email reportabuse@salinadiocese.org to disclose any confidential facts. All of us need Christ's healing, and if you or a family member have been so harmed, please let us help direct you to those who can help.

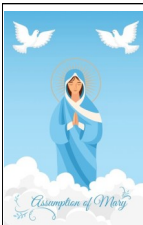
