Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time — Sunday, August 30, 2026



It is no easy task being a parent today. The pressures of the world, the temptations our young people face in the culture, and the overall assault of the enemy upon the family can make caring for children and grandchildren feel like an overwhelming task. In today's world, it is likely that all of us feel the burden of family members who have abandoned the Church or faith in general. This reality can weigh heavy upon our hearts.

This past week we celebrated a very unique combination of saints. We celebrated St. Monica on Thursday and her son, St. Augustine, on Friday. Initially, most of us may not think our lives compare to a mother/son combination of saints. But what is particularly unique about Monica and Augustine is how relatable their lives were to what so many of us experience.

Monica was a devout Christian who lived in the 4th century. Unfortunately, her son Augustine did not follow her in the faith and lived a pagan lifestyle for many years of his youth and young adulthood. Augustine's lifestyle weighed heavy upon his mother Monica. For years, Monica was perseverant in begging Our Lord for Augustine's conversion without seeming to gain the result she desired. She shed many tears for her wayward son. However, eventually Augustine did convert and became the great saint we know him today. Interestingly, Augustine's conversion was not particularly through the direct influence of his mother Monica. Augustine's conversion came more directly through the influence of another great saint of this era, the bishop St. Ambrose.

This story gives me hope. For those of us with wayward children, grandchildren, siblings, family, and friends, we have confidence in approaching the Lord. We can pray that those we love will be open and receptive to meeting the Ambrose who the Lord may place in their lives to bring them home. Often times, you and I will not be the Ambrose. We may not be the ones who directly participate in the conversion of our loved ones. But we can all be Monica. We can all beg Our Lord for His grace to penetrate the hearts of those we love; even the hearts of the most hardened and wayward. Like Monica, our hidden, persevering prayers may be indispensable keys in helping them receive these graces. St. Monica and St. Augustine – pray for our families!

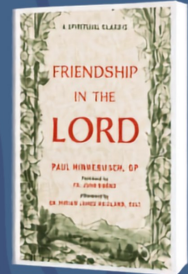
