Christmas Eve – Calling All Altar Servers!!!

We would like to invite all altar servers who would like to vest and “sit in choir” to come to our Christmas Eve Mass on December 24th at 4:00pm!

On Christmas Eve, we will utilize our regularly scheduled altar servers for Mass. However, now that we have new and more cassocks and surplices, we have the opportunity during special celebrations to invite all other servers who want to be part of the celebration to participate.

This role is rather simple. Any server who would like is welcome to dress in cassock and surplice. Servers who will be “sitting in choir” may take their cassock/surplice to the Bride’s Room and vest and gather there prior to Mass. If a server cannot find the proper size of cassock/surplice in the minister’s sacristy, we will have extras in the Bride’s Room.

Then, when it is time for Mass, all servers will gather in the gathering space. After the blessing of the crib, everyone will line up to process into the church with the primary servers leading, and those “sitting in choir” following behind, with the lector and clergy following at the end. Those “sitting in choir,” once they reach the foot of the sanctuary, will genuflect, and immediately go to pews which will be reserved for them. They will remain in these pews until the end of Mass, in which they will exit the pews to process out immediately following the primary servers (as they processed in).

With that, if any server would like to sit in choir, please contact the parish office to let us know. This way we will know how many servers to expect, and will be able to reserve the proper number of pews for them.

Thank you in advance to all servers who are willing to come “sit in choir,” as well as for all your great work and service at our Masses! We really appreciate it!
