Using Patens

Beginning this weekend, we will be implementing the use of patens during Communion. Patens are the golden “plates” which will be held by the altar servers for those receiving the Precious Body during Mass. The use of patens was once quite common in the Church. Although for the past several years they have been rare, they are now gradually coming back into use in various places.

There are two reasons for utilizing this practice. The first is practical. The server will hold the paten under the hands or chin of those receiving Communion just in case a host falls, they are able to catch it. This better helps to ensure that the Blessed Sacrament is never dropped on the ground.

The second reason is more formative. The basic premise is that the way people worship will have an impact on what people believe. In essence, the more we approach and treat the Eucharist as Christ Himself, the more people will truly believe that it is the real presence of Christ Himself. Not only does this help to form the belief of Catholics, but it is a great way to show our faith to all others; it is a witness that we do not believe this to be some ordinary symbolic piece of bread. The Eucharist is the true presence Jesus Christ!
