## Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time — Sunday, February 8, 2026

### Reclaiming the Lord's Day – Reclaiming the Mass Part 4: The Giving – Another Perspective

Thus far in our series on reclaiming the Mass, we have presented the true purpose of the Mass, being to give praise and thanks to God (Part 2), and what exactly it is that we are to give (Part 3). This week, I would like to offer another perspective on how we are to give of ourselves through a small but significant moment of the Mass.

#### More on the Giving

Last week, we discussed how we are to give of ourselves to the Mass by explaining the connection between “The Liturgy of the Mass” and “The liturgy of our lives.” The liturgy of our lives consists of all the work of the Lord in which we participate from day to day, including our prayers, devotions, sacrifices, works of mercy, and even the day-to-day tasks that God calls us to perform, making even the most mundane part of the work of the Lord. When we come to Mass, we recollect and collect all we have done as part of the liturgy of our lives, and this is what we offer to God at the Liturgy of the Mass.

In addition, though, we want to be able to truly offer to God *everything* we can in our lives. All our gifts and blessings, joys and sorrows, successes and failures, and everything in between should be given back to the Lord. This can lead us to a deeper understanding of a simple but profound moment of the Mass – the offertory.

#### The Offertory

Although it is a brief moment in the Mass, the offertory truly has great spiritual significance. On the outside, it looks like this is simply a time to set up the altar, take up a collection, and bring forward the bread and wine so that we can continue with Mass. Yet the offertory is much more than that.

When the gifts are brought to the altar, we are not just presenting bread, wine, and a collection. In a real way, this moment highlights how we are bringing *our entire selves* to the altar! As you see the people walking down the aisle towards the sanctuary, we also place the actions from the liturgy of our lives, as well as our joys and sorrows, friends and families, successes and failures... we bring our *entire lives* to the altar as an offering and sacrifice for the Lord.

Because of this, some liturgists have called the entire Mass an offertory. From the beginning to the end of the Mass, we are offering ourselves to God. The more we are able to do this, the more we are able to offer our lives to God as a whole.

#### A Final Thought

With all of this, I once knew a Bishop who encouraged the people – when the basket is passed around at Mass, even if you do not have a *monetary* offering, place your hand inside the basket anyways; let this be a sign that you are placing *yourself* in the basket to be brought forward with the gifts to the altar of the Lord.

Whether you choose to do this or not is completely up to you. Nonetheless, let us continue to offer our lives to the Lord; in reality, the gift of yourself is worth more than anything anyone could put in the basket anyways. —Fr. Nick Parker
