Reclaiming the Lord's Day Reclaiming the Mass

Earlier this year, in a meeting among the Hays pastors, a discussion was held regarding how to bring people back to the fundamentals of the faith, while bringing others, especially nonpracticing Catholics, back to the Church. In this discussion, a simple theme (taken from a poster at the Spiritual Life Center in Wichita) was brought forward: Renewal of parish life and family life by reclaiming Sunday as the Lord's day. To reclaim Sunday as the Lord's day is truly a worthy endeavor that strikes at the heart of our faith. In order to do this, though, it seems also necessary to reclaim the true purpose of the Mass itself.

Therefore, in the following weeks, I hope to offer a series of articles about the true nature of the Mass. What is its true purpose? What are some of the common traps and misconceptions regarding the Mass? How do we understand the nature of the Mass, and how should that influence our participation in it?

My hope is that not only will this be helpful and enlightening, but it might allow us to be able to enter more fully into true worship in the Liturgy. With this, may we reclaim the true nature of the Mass, and hence reclaim the day of the Lord.
