Part 2: Reclaiming the True Purpose

The dilemma – Covid's reveal of faulty formation

About 5 years ago, many parishes were shut down in response to the Covid pandemic. However, when churches reopened, it was noted across the United States, including Ellis county, that a significant number of parishioners never returned. Why? One reason is because Covid enacted a great reveal; it showed the result of years of faulty teachings and poor faith formation of the faithful.

Think of it this way: For decades, when the question was asked, "Why should we go to Mass?" what was the answer? Normally, the response from parishioners, catechists, and even priests was based on a single premise – because of "what we get out of it!"

We go because we are fed by God's Word and the Eucharist. We go because we receive spiritual rest. We go because we get the rejuvenation we need to take on another week. We go because of *what we get*.

All of these answers sound nice, but in reality, they are all erroneous; none of these answers actually refer to the true purpose, and therefore should not be the true motivation, for going to Mass. Couple this with the fact that in many places, it was and still is praiseworthy to make deliberate changes and adaptations to the Mass, big or small (something that in normal circumstances is never legitimately allowed), so that people can "get more out of it," and our own practices malfom the faithful and lead them astray from the true essence of worship.

With this in mind, what happened when people experienced the Covid shutdown? The Sunday experience completely changed. People were able to sleep in, finding the rest they desired. Families did not have to stress about getting around and being somewhere on time, allowing for carefree family time and rejuvenation for the rest of the week. Many still watched Mass online (which is never a permissible substitute for actually attending, but more on this in a future article), or they prayed on their own, granting them the ability to still be fed in a way that was personally satisfactory. In the end, people learned that all of the reasons for which they had been taught as to why they should attend Mass – all that they were supposed to "get out of it" – could be found in an easier, and sometimes even more abundant way by staying home than by actually going to Mass. And to make matters worse, it is our own faulty logic that led to these conclusions. Hence, Covid revealed the result of the decades of poor faith formation of the faithful.

Reclaiming the true purpose of Mass

This is why it is important to return once again to the true purpose of the Mass. The true purpose of the Mass is this – to give praise and thanks to God. Notice with this definition, however, that the primary purpose is to give, **not** to get.

This makes the Mass somewhat contrary to our normal spiritual mindset. Often our motivation for going to God in our regular day to day lives is to ask Him for whatever we might want or need. Yet, the Mass is different. Mass is our time to give. Although we do offer petitions to God during the Mass, this is not the central purpose of the Mass. In addition, our petitions in Mass are not meant for us to simply receive what we ask; their deeper intent is that we are asking what we need so that we might be able to more fully give back to God.

Still, what exactly are we supposed to give to God? We want to offer our lives to God, but what does this look like, and how do we do this? These are some of the questions I hope to answer in the next bulletin article. In the meantime, let it suffice to say that in essence, Mass is the time to realize that our entire existence is for the glory of God. We exist for Him, not Him for us. Therefore, let us make sure to use this time to give more fully of ourselves to the Lord as we enter into the Mass.

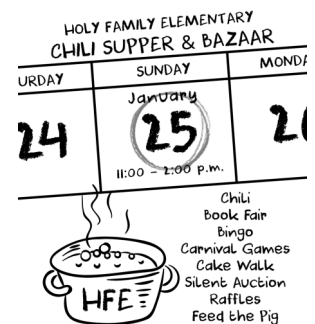
