Hello IHM Parish! It's Deacon Kyle, back again for another article. This week I'd like to talk about a subject near and dear to my heart—the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother and the Queen of the Universe. But before I extol her glory, I need to put her in context with the rest of the Church's Teachings. I've mentioned many times in my homilies two themes:

1. Intimacy with God the Father in prayer
2. And St Thomas Aquinas' Teaching that the "Law of the Gospel" is to be lead by the Holy Spirit within us.

Our whole lives should revolve around fostering these two things. Jesus helps us with this by showing us both His human love for us and the Father, and by showing us what a Spirit-lead life looks like. Mary's job, then, is to assist Jesus in this mission. She shows us what a specifically feminine love for us and God looks like. This is so comforting! God is gentle, kind, empathetic, nurturing, etc. But every little child instinctively responds better to receiving these things from his mother. So too our hearts benefit greatly from having a mother who loves us more than a million mothers combined.

Furthermore, she is Jesus' most perfect disciple. St Maximillian Kolbe speaks as if she is almost the "Holy Spirit incarnate"—this is because she is completely empty of herself and docile to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit—she allows herself to be moved by Him, in the same way wind moves a sail-boat.

Finally, she shows us how to receive Jesus' Sacrifice and the sufferings of others, by the way she lets the Passion pierce her heart. St Louis de Montfort says that when we give Mary our heart, she receives it into her own, she melts it and molds until it resembles hers and the Lord's! Let us therefore go to our Lady in prayer—let her be your mother, strengthen your soul and conform your life to the pattern of her Son. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

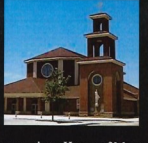

Exclusive Screening of *Triumph of the Heart*

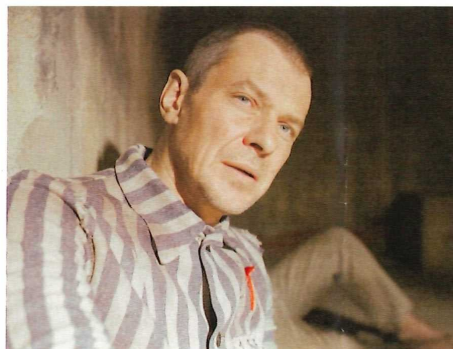
