Liturgical Items and Help Funding Altar Server Cassocks and Surplices

Donations and Liturgical Items

This week, we are asking members of IHM to consider a contribution to help purchase new cassocks and surplices for our altar servers!

Recently, thanks to a couple of generous contributions from parishioners, we have received funds for a number of various liturgical items for our church! (More on that in the near future). Thank you very much to those donors! We are incredibly grateful! One item on our wish list is new cassocks and surplices for our altar servers.

The Motivation

Although our cassocks and surplices are still functional, it is necessary to purchase new ones to replace those that are getting worn, as well as those that have been lost or misplaced.

Another major motivation behind this comes from the experience we had with our Grand Reopening last November. During this time, we invited all servers who wanted to participate to come. We had to borrow cassocks and surplices from another parish in our diocese to make this happen, but we were able to make it work. Having a large number of servers really added to the grandeur of the celebration, not to mention allowed many more of our youth to participate in the Mass. If we had more cassocks and surplices, we could continue this practice on special occasions, such as Christmas or Easter Masses.

How You Can Help

This is where our parishioners come in. Although the kind donations are able to cover the vast majority of the cost for our liturgical items, we are still needing some funding for the entirety of the cassocks and surplices. The total amount needed to cover the rest of the cost of the cassocks and surplices is \$3,200.

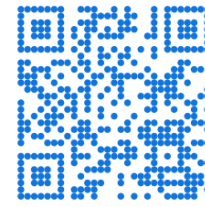

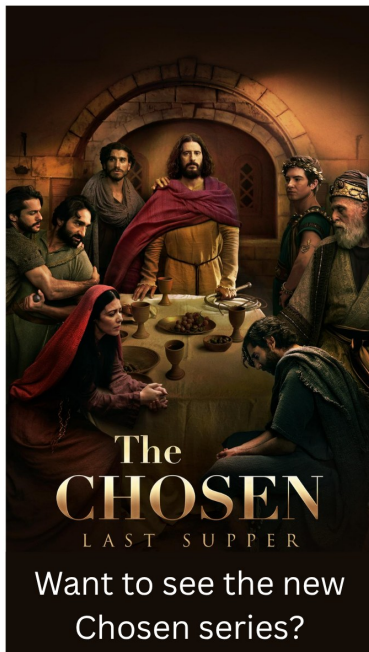
