Hello IHM! This week I would like to share a couple book recommendations with you. These have all been formative for me, and are modern-day classics which teach the Faith's spiritual tradition in a deep but accessible way. If you want to super-charge your relationship with God, look these up!

***Fulfillment of All Desire*, by Ralph Martin.** This is one of Bishop Vinke's favorite books, and was probably the most formative one for my prayer life after Augustine's *Confessions*. It provides a "road-map" for the Spiritual Life, leading you from the beginnings of prayer to mystical contemplation, using 7 Doctors of the Church as your guides: St. Augustine, St. Francis De Sales, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Bernard of Clairvaux, St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, and St. Therese of Lisieux.

***Discernment of Spirits*, by Fr. Timothy Gallagher.** This is another huge one for me, probably my third favorite book. It analyzes the writing of St Ignatius of Loyola—teaching you how to listen to God's Voice in your everyday life, and engage in spiritual combat with the Enemy. Very down-to-earth style, yet deep. (Bonus: His book on the Examen Prayer helps add another essential "spiritual tool" to your tool-belt.)

***Three Ages of the Spiritual Life*, by Fr. Reginald Garrigou-Lagrange.** This one isn't necessarily "accessible" or "down-to-earth", because it's sort of a more "theology-heavy" version of Ralph Martin's book, providing a road-map of the spiritual life, combined with insights from St Thomas Aquinas. But if you think you have what it takes, it's AWESOME!

***I Believe in Love: A Personal Retreat Based on the Teachings of Therese of Lisieux*, by Fr. Jean C.J. d'El-bée.** Ever struggle with an excessively guilty conscience? Anxiety? Depression? Struggling to make any progress in personal growth? This book teaches you how to cast all your cares on the Lord, and develop a deep, unshakeable sense of trust in His Love.
