The Financial Situation of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish

In May and June, our Finance Council met to review the finances over the past fiscal year, and work on a budget for next year. With these recent meetings, I would like to take the opportunity to update the parish on the finances at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish.

The Good News

To begin, we are happy to say that this year, we have balanced our budget, and we are ending the fiscal year ahead in our finances! I would like to thank our Finance Council for their hard work in this endeavor. Mostly, though, I would like to thank *the kind and generous parishioners of IHM*, who have offered their prayers and sacrifices for the well-being of our parish! You have truly made a difference!

The Continued Awareness

Looking at our upcoming fiscal year, our Finance Council has built a new budget, which although offers a balanced budget, does so just barely. Therefore, it is important that we continue to be diligent in our efforts to provide for the church's expenses and the needs of our parish.

How You Can Help

One of the reasons why parishes often find themselves in financial struggle is not because of a lack of good and consistent contributors; rather, it is because consistent giving is unable to keep up with consistent *increase* in expenses. It is important to remember that, even with attempts to cut expenses, the cost of running the parish naturally goes up each year. This is because of a rise in utilities, insurance, maintenance, etc. Therefore, it is important every year for all of us, especially as we hopefully receive some sort of raise of income each year, to reevaluate our finances, and discern whether we can continue to give more as well.

Last year, we asked everyone to give an increase of \$5 to \$10 a week to help cover our expenses. This year, once again thanks to our generous parishioners, we are in a much better position. We still ask all our parishioners to continue with their generous giving; however, if you could increase your giving by another \$5 to \$10 each month, this would have a great impact and help us to meet our financial goals for the upcoming year. Of course, if you do not tithe regularly, this would be a good opportunity to start!

Please know, no matter what or how you contribute to our parish, we are most grateful.

How You Can Give

Please remember the many ways you can financially contribute to our parish:

1. The Collection Basket – The collection basket is passed around at every weekend Mass. We do want to make an effort, for financial and especially for spiritual reasons, to have the basket passed to every person in the pews. We will continue to make these efforts so that everyone will have the opportunity to offer what they are able.
2. Envelopes – Every registered parishioner should receive a packet of envelopes. Please continue to use these as you see fit.
3. ACH – ACH withdrawals are an excellent way to set up electronic donations directly from your bank account to the parish. They are a great way to ensure consistent giving. If you would like to set up an ACH, or if you would like to increase your current ACH, please contact Debbie Nunnelee in the parish office.

5. Prayers! – Your prayers, above all, make the most profound difference! Thank you all very much for your continued prayers for our parish!

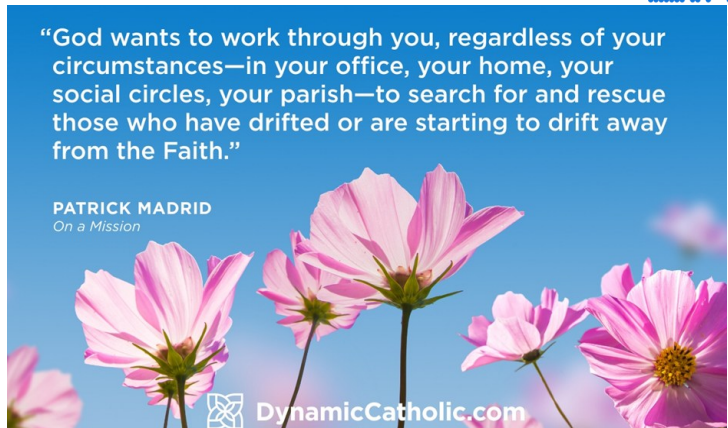
Summertime Reminders — The church fiscal year ends June 30. Please have your final fiscal year 2025-2026 donations in by **Tuesday, June 30**.
