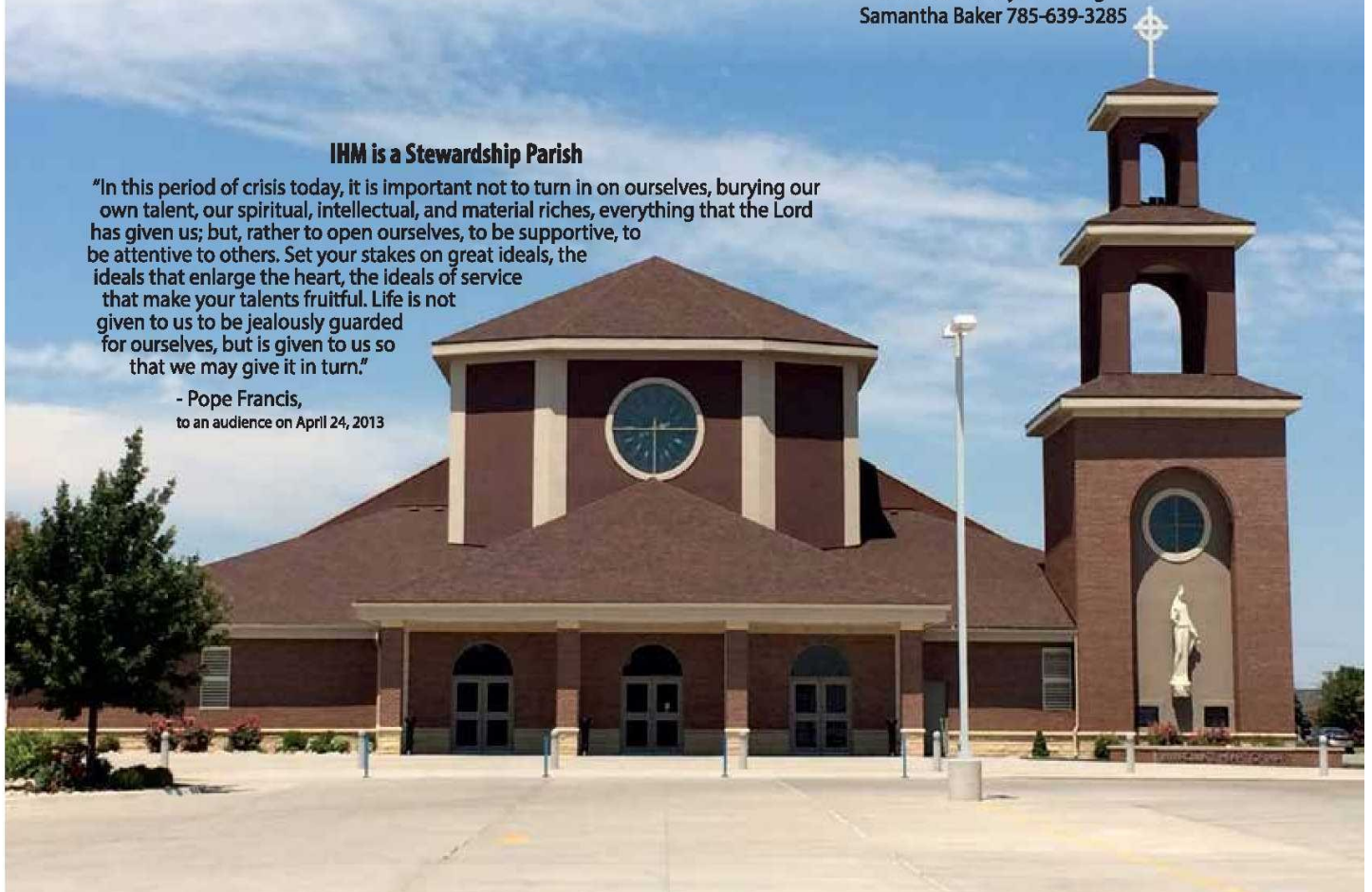

So before I leave, let me say that I truly appreciate the warm welcome I received when I moved here. I loved getting to spend so much time in our Catholic schools. While I will definitely miss being here, I am very excited for the adventure that lies ahead of me as I join the Navy Chaplain Corps.

Dear Parents of Incoming 2nd-8th Grade Students,

As promised, we are writing to share additional information about the move to Restored Order in the three Hays Parishes. During the month of August, we will be hosting four half-hour meetings with parents about Restored Order and how the process will unfold in our three parishes. Three of these meetings will be in English and one will be in Spanish. All four meetings will include the same information, so it is necessary to attend only one. You are asked to attend whichever session is most convenient for you, regardless of which church is hosting the meeting. Again, all the information presented at these sessions will be the same, and all three of us and our pastors, as they are able, will be present at each of these meetings to address our move to Restored Order and answer any questions you may have. Students do NOT need to attend. These sessions will be held:

- **Wednesday, August 5** in the Immaculate Heart of Mary parish hall at 6:00pm in English and 7:00pm in Spanish
- **Wednesday, August 12** in St. Joseph Church at 6:30pm
- **Sunday, August 16** in the St. Nicholas of Myra parish hall at 3:00pm

Following the series of meetings, we will compile a list of Frequently Asked Questions and their answers so that anything that may have been asked at one meeting and not others will be answered for all. We will share that information with you through email; our respective parishes' social media accounts, bulletins, and websites; and through communication through our Catholic Schools newsletters.

It is imperative that you plan to attend one of these sessions so as to remain informed about the expectations, requirements, and deadlines that will accompany this move to Restored Order in our tri-parish community.

We look forward to seeing you in August!
