Reclaiming the Lord's Day - Reclaiming the Mass Part 8: Why Not On My Own??? – Part 3
Religion is Personal???

The Dilemma

It is a very common and popular understanding in the world today – faith is personal. After all, Christ calls us each, individually, by name. He wants a deep and intimate relationship with each and every one of us. Therefore, our relationship with Christ should be something unique, particular to ourselves, and something we can truly call our own. This is what is known today as “Personal” or “Privatized Religion.”

Although there is some truth to this, the idea that faith is *solely* personal fails to understand other essential aspects of religion, as well as contains many elements that can deceptively lead one astray. “Personal” or “Privatized Religion” means that my faith, including what I believe or not believe, what I choose to be right or wrong, how I pray, worship, love, and serve others, is determined by me, and is between God and me. Not only is this simply wrong, but it has the potential to put the soul in grave mortal danger! After all, Jesus Himself says, “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven.” (Mt 7:21).

With this, it is essential that we know the errors of a personalized religion, what true religion should be, how it relates to the Mass, and ultimately, how it leads us to salvation.

True Essence of Religion

To begin, it is helpful to know something about the word “religion.” The word actually comes from a Latin word, “religatio,” which means “binding.” What exactly does religion bind? Everything!

The entirety of the Scriptures, as well as the early Church, understood this well. All of creation is bound together by God. Our faith and how we practice it has an effect on how we view and interact with others and the world around us. Even though there may be things we do (good or bad) in private, nothing in our faith life is purely and solely “personal.”

Because of this, the notion of a “privatized religion” was completely foreign to the people of the Scriptures. The very term “personal religion” is oxymoronic. In fact, this is also why, although everyone should have a deep and personal relationship with the Lord, accepting Jesus Christ under the title as “personal Lord and Savior” is found nowhere in the Scriptures.

Are You Saved???

Now we will apply this notion to Salvation. It has been a common question asked when trying to evangelize – are you saved? Although it is a question that should be taken seriously, in a sense, the question itself is misleading.

First, how does salvation work? To begin, we have to look at salvation history. Keep in mind, in the entirety of the Bible, from Genesis to Revelation, God always strives to establish and gather “His people,” “His flock,” “His community of believers.” In other words, He strives to establish His Church! And why does He wish to establish this flock/community? Because it is through this mode that He will save His people!

Think about this in light of the saving work of Christ. Christ has already won the victory! Sin and death are defeated! He has brought salvation! But salvation for who? For His community of believers. Salvation is won for the Church.

This is why the question, “Are you saved?” is somewhat misleading. Seeing the saving work of Christ, we must realize that the Church is already saved! Either we are saved with the Church, or not at all. Now the real question is, how are we living in union with Christ's Church?

The Mass

Hopefully with this, we can now understand the errors and spiritual dangers of a privatized religion. Finally, though, we must relate this to the Mass.

What is the Mass? Over the past several weeks we have understood it in a number of ways. One more essential understanding is this – it is the epitome of the Church's worship in union with all the angels and Saints at the victorious wedding feast of the Lamb! In other words, it is our participation in Christ's triumph over sin and death.

It is because of this that keeping the Lord's Day holy by our participation in the Mass is directly linked to our salvation. Here, we gather in union with God's flock – His Church – to become united with Christ in offering ourselves to God in true worship. It is the most fundamental, most central, and most essential part of living our faith. It is through this that we follow the will of the Father, becoming fully united as God's Church, united with our Lord Jesus Christ, and ultimately, brought to salvation.
