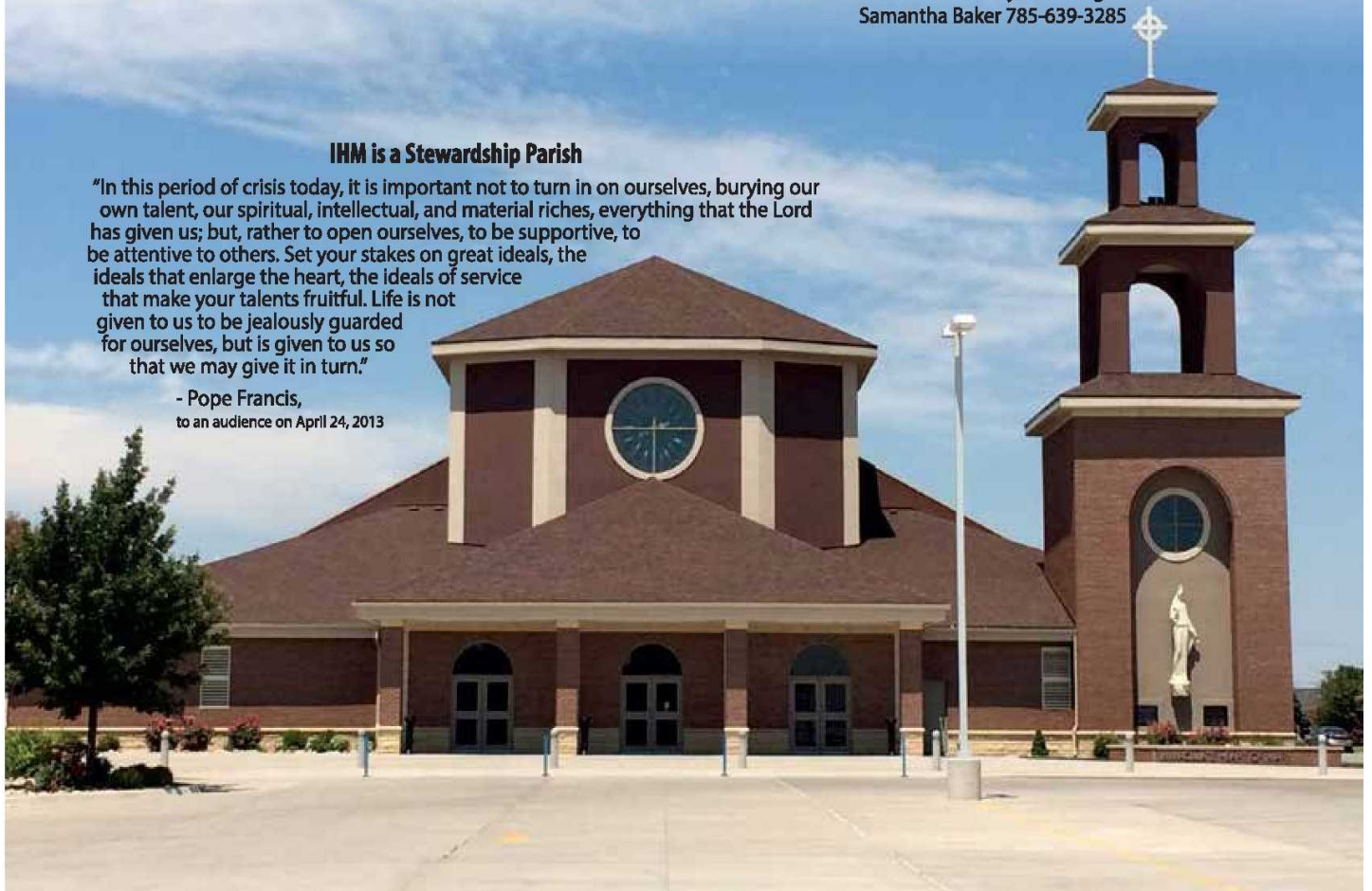

## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord — Sunday, March 29, 2026

### Holy Week

This week, we enter into Holy Week with the celebration of Palm Sunday. This is one of the most extreme liturgical celebrations of the year. We begin with reading a Gospel praising Jesus as He enters into Jerusalem, but shortly after, we participate in His crucifixion. It is a great time to meditate on the fickleness of humanity, how we can be greatly devoted to Christ one minute, but falling into sin the next. Yet, through all of it, our Lord is always faithful to us. Following the celebration of Palm Sunday, the next major celebrations of the Church are the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter).

*Holy Thursday (7:00 p.m.)* – Holy Thursday celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood. One unique aspect of this celebration is the washing of the feet. In addition, Holy Thursday ends with a Eucharistic procession throughout the church, ending with the Blessed Sacrament being taken to the Adoration Chapel. The Adoration Chapel will remain open until 11:00 p.m., when Jesus in the Eucharist will be placed in the tabernacle until we celebrate His Resurrection at Easter.

*Good Friday (3:00 p.m., 6:30 p.m. Spanish)* – On Good Friday, we recall the crucifixion and death of Jesus. During this service, there is customarily a veneration of the Cross. Veneration can actually be done in a variety of ways according to the preference of the person, including the following gestures: Options for veneration include a genuflection, bow, a touching of the Cross with your hand, or even a kiss of the Cross. Anyone who prefers to venerate the Cross by remaining kneeling in the pew is free to do so as well.

*Easter Vigil (8:30 p.m.)* – This is the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord! Although this is a significantly longer Mass, there is none as unique as this Mass throughout the entire year. It is really something to experience! A highlight of this Mass is the very beginning, when the church is in complete darkness. We bless a fire outside (weather permitting), and light the Paschal Candle (a symbol of Christ Resurrected). Then, we process into the church, each person holding a candle, and little by little, everyone's candle is lit (a sign of Christ's light spreading throughout the world). The church gradually becomes illuminated with the light of Christ! During this ceremony, we will be bringing new members into the Church as well. Please come to support the new members of our Church, as well as to celebrate the greatest celebration of the year!

*Easter Day (8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m. Spanish)* – We continue to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. Please note that there will be no 5:00 p.m. Confessions or 6:00 p.m. Mass on this day. Be sure to come celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

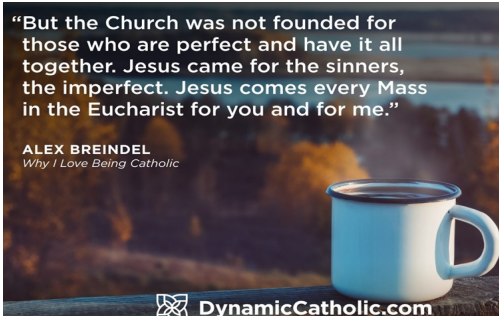

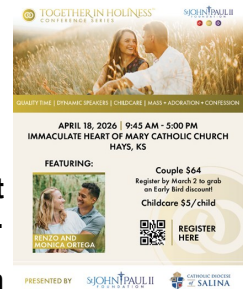
