Thanksgiving and Advent

This upcoming Thursday, we celebrate Thanksgiving Day, and next weekend, we enter into Advent. As a whole, this is a time in which we remember the many things in life for which we are thankful. We are thankful for friends, for family, for our community, as well as for all that has been provided to us for our well-being throughout the year, and throughout our lives.

This also calls to mind the importance of gratitude in the spiritual life. It has been said that discipleship to Christ cannot begin without this essential virtue. When we think about this, we will see how true it is.

How does discipleship begin? In all of Scripture, it begins as a *grateful response* to some sort of gift or sign of the love and blessings of God. Think of Abraham’s response to God’s promises and gifting him with the birth of his son. Think of the disciples’ call to Christ, particularly Peter after his miraculous catch of fish. Think of the first letter of John where we read, “We love because *he first loved us*” (1 John 4:19). This, in and of itself, gives us much to ponder.

First, what love and blessings have we received from God? If we wish to take this a step further, what love and blessings do we have in life that is *not* from God? In reality, all that is good is from our Lord. Everything we have is from Him. Our entire life, our entire being, all that is within it, and our opportunity for Salvation is undeserved gift from God. In particular, we are entering into a season in which we prepare for the greatest gift that God the Father has ever given us – the gift of Jesus Christ, His son!

The more we grow in this acknowledgement of God’s gifts, the more motivation we have to grow in gratitude. And with gratitude, there must always be a response. In particular, if we are truly grateful for the gifts God has given us, the only appropriate reaction is to be His disciples.

Discipleship truly does begin with gratitude. Therefore, as we celebrate the holiday of Thanksgiving, and as we enter the season of Advent, let us continue to reflect on all the blessings in our lives. Let us not only be thankful for them, but let us also acknowledge God as the ultimate source of them all. With this, let us gratefully respond to these blessings by striving to always become greater disciples of our Lord.
