## The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica— Sunday, November 9, 2025

### Feast Day of St. John Lateran Basilica



This weekend, we celebrate a rather odd feast day – the feast of St. John Lateran Basilica. This feast always occurs on November 9th, although the date rarely lands on a Sunday. Why is this feast day odd? Because it is not actually the feast day of a Saint, but rather it commemorates the day of dedication of a basilica in Rome.

The basilica of St. John Lateran is actually a Cathedral. Every bishop around the world has his own Cathedral. The Cathedral of St. John Lateran is the Pope’s Cathedral, to be precise, as he is also the Bishop of Rome. Because of this, one could consider St. John Lateran to be the “Mother Church” of the Catholic world.

This feast day, although odd, is always a good time to reflect on the Church. What is the Church?

Is it a building? Well, that’s actually not a bad answer. There should be something unique, special, and even sacred about a building that makes it stand apart as a church. But there are other ways to understand the Church as well.

Is it the people? Once again, a good answer! Even more important than a building is the communion of the people themselves.

One of my favorite definitions of the Church actually comes from the Greek word for “church,” which is “ekklesia.” This is actually a compound word in Greek – “ek,” meaning “out,” and “kaleo,” meaning “called.” Hence, the actual definition of the word “church” in Greek means “called out from.” What does this mean? It means that, as “Church,” we are “called out from” this world, and called to live in the life and Heavenly world of Christ.

With this, there may be many definitions and understandings for the word “Church,” yet all of them should include the notion that the Church is to be something different. It is not to be like anything else in the world. It is “otherworldly,” in the sense that it is always to be an image of the Heavenly life in Christ. In all of our concepts and understandings of the Church, may we always strive to let them be a witness to this call to live in the life of Christ.
