Communal Anointing of the Sick

This weekend after each Mass we will be having a communal Anointing of the Sick. This Sacrament can be celebrated for anyone who may be struggling with any serious ailment. This can include those of serious illness or disease (meaning much more serious than something like the flu or a common cold), as well as those preparing for a surgery. It can also be celebrated for those who are struggling with serious mental or emotional difficulties (such as depression or anxiety). Those who are considered elderly are able to receive the Sacrament as well.

It should also be noted that, if you have received the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick relatively recently (generally within the last month or so), there is no need to receive the Sacrament again. However, for a person who has received the Anointing of the Sick, if that person's condition has worsened or has even remained relatively the same, that person is more than welcome to receive the Sacrament again.

It is important to know that this Sacrament does involve physical touching, particularly a laying of hands on top of the head, and the anointing with oil on the forehead and the palms. If, due to health concerns, one is uncomfortable with this form of contact, especially in the context of a group of people, that is understandable. In this case, if you would like to receive the Anointing of the Sick, I might recommend contacting the parish office and scheduling a separate, individual time to receive the Sacrament. In addition, if anyone is feeling sick with something that might be contagious, I would ask that you refrain from attending this service at this time. However, please contact the parish office so that we can offer you the Anointing of the Sick at another time that works best for you.

If anyone has any questions regarding whether or not you are able to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please do not hesitate to ask. In addition, if you are unable to attend the communal service, and you are wanting to receive the Sacrament, please know that I am happy to find another time to administer the Sacrament for you.

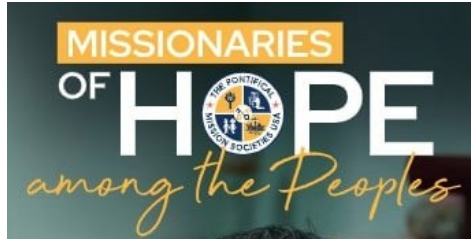

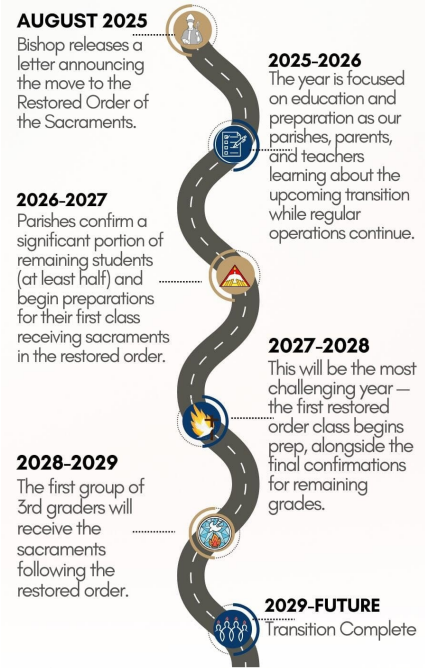
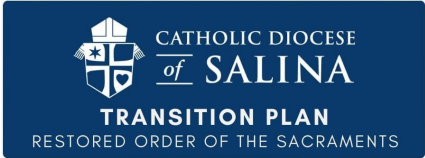
