Help Us Pay Off Our Loan

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to ask for your help at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish. However, I would first like to thank you for all your tremendous prayers, involvement, and support of our parish! Our parish continues to be a vibrant family of faith, and for your part in this, we are truly grateful!

Our Extraordinary Blessings

Almost 4 years ago, Immaculate Heart of Parish launched the "Unify, Beautify, Glorify" campaign for our church projects. In April of 2024, we completed our parish hall and basement. The following November, on Christ the King Sunday, we celebrated the grand re-opening of our church. Now, in just a few months, we plan for the completion of our rectory.

Because of this, we are beginning to see the fruits of these efforts beyond what we initially imagined! Our parish hall is changing the life of our parish, allowing us to gather as a people for multiple events. This includes regular Sunday breakfasts, educational opportunities (like watching "The Chosen" series), and various social gatherings. We are able to offer funeral dinners, wedding receptions, and a venue for other occasions as well! Our basement also finally provides meeting space for the many organizations and ministries of our parish.

Not only is our church stunningly beautiful, contributing to prayer, Masses, and other liturgical celebrations, but our diocese named it a pilgrimage site for the Jubilee Year of Mercy. It has also gained national attention through online liturgical articles and social media exposure!

With the completion of the rectory, we will be able to not only house our priests, but we will finally have space for missionaries and speakers, guest priests and seminarians, and the Bishop when he visits for local events.

Where You Come In

When we began our projects, the cost was estimated to total approximately \$6 million. Having performed a feasibility study, we knew that this was achievable, but only with the help of the diocese providing us a loan, which we would pay off in the next several years. The diocese, after reviewing our finances and plans, generously provided a \$2.1 million loan for our projects.

With our projects reaching full completion, we are once again in need of your help. Many of our parishioners have already made very generous contributions to our church projects; for this we are incredibly grateful! At the same time, with us now needing to pay off our loan, I am asking if you would once again be willing to contribute to our church projects.

If you previously offered a multi-year pledge, would you be willing to renew that pledge, even if for a lesser amount, for the next few years?

If you offered a one-time gift, would you be willing to offer that one-time gift again?

If you were unable to offer monetary support for our building projects in the past, now that we are able to see and enjoy the blessings of these projects, would you be able and willing to offer some form of financial support to help pay the diocesan loan for these projects?

Any gift you are able to give is most appreciated. If you are unable to help financially, however, please know that your prayers for our church, especially for our parish family, are the most powerful and valuable gift anyone could provide!
