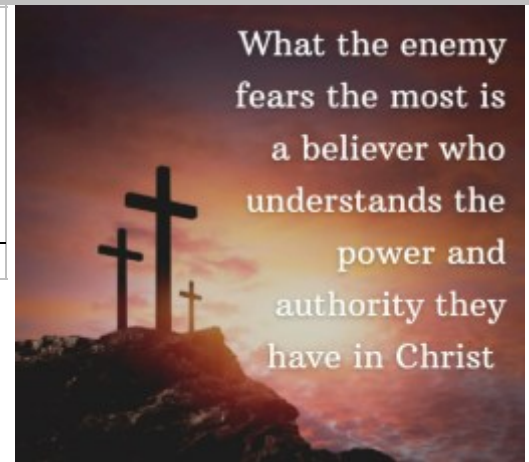

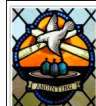

### Kolbe Prison Ministries

With the blessings of Bishop Vincke, a Catholic men's retreat was conducted in the Ellsworth Correctional Facility by Kolbe Prison Ministries (KPM) a few weeks ago. This three-day retreat was held on July 10-12, and was attended by 39 Catholic men, and about 20 volunteers. The retreat had a very significant impact on the residents and most of the residents expressed this at the close of the retreat. What a great success!

Many residents see Christ and return to Him through these deeply spiritual experiences. Volunteers will now be conducting a Catholic retreat at the other remaining prison in our Salina Diocese, the Norton Correctional Facility, on October 22-24. We are once again seeking your support for this vital work. The devil is at work within the walls of the prison, and prayers are imperative to bring the hope of Jesus Christ to these men.

There are three ways to help support this retreat: prayer, as a volunteer, or with financial support. Feel free to donate through the church collection by marking an envelope "KPM". The ministry must raise funds to provide meals and supplies (Bibles, rosaries, etc.) for the residents. ### Job Opening at Holy Family Elementary School, Hays, Kansas

Holy Family Elementary is hiring a full-time, 40-hour-a-week custodian to work year-round, including summer. This position offers benefits, including sick pay and vacation. The schedule is flexible.

This position reports to and receives direction from our maintenance director. The person hired must be self-motivated, as duties given are typically done solo. The person hired must be able to keep up with the fast pace of a school day. Work during the summer is slower-paced but involves deep cleaning and construction work.

Duties include picking up trash, dusting, sweeping, mopping, wiping tables and chairs, and maintaining bathrooms. They also include tasks such as painting, changing lightbulbs, fixing toilets, and waxing floors. The person hired must be able to physically lift 50 pounds or more and move easily on stairs and ladders.

The person hired must be comfortable with children ages 3-11. This person will be in the presence of children, but will not be asked to monitor them. This person must complete our Safe Environment Training & background check.
