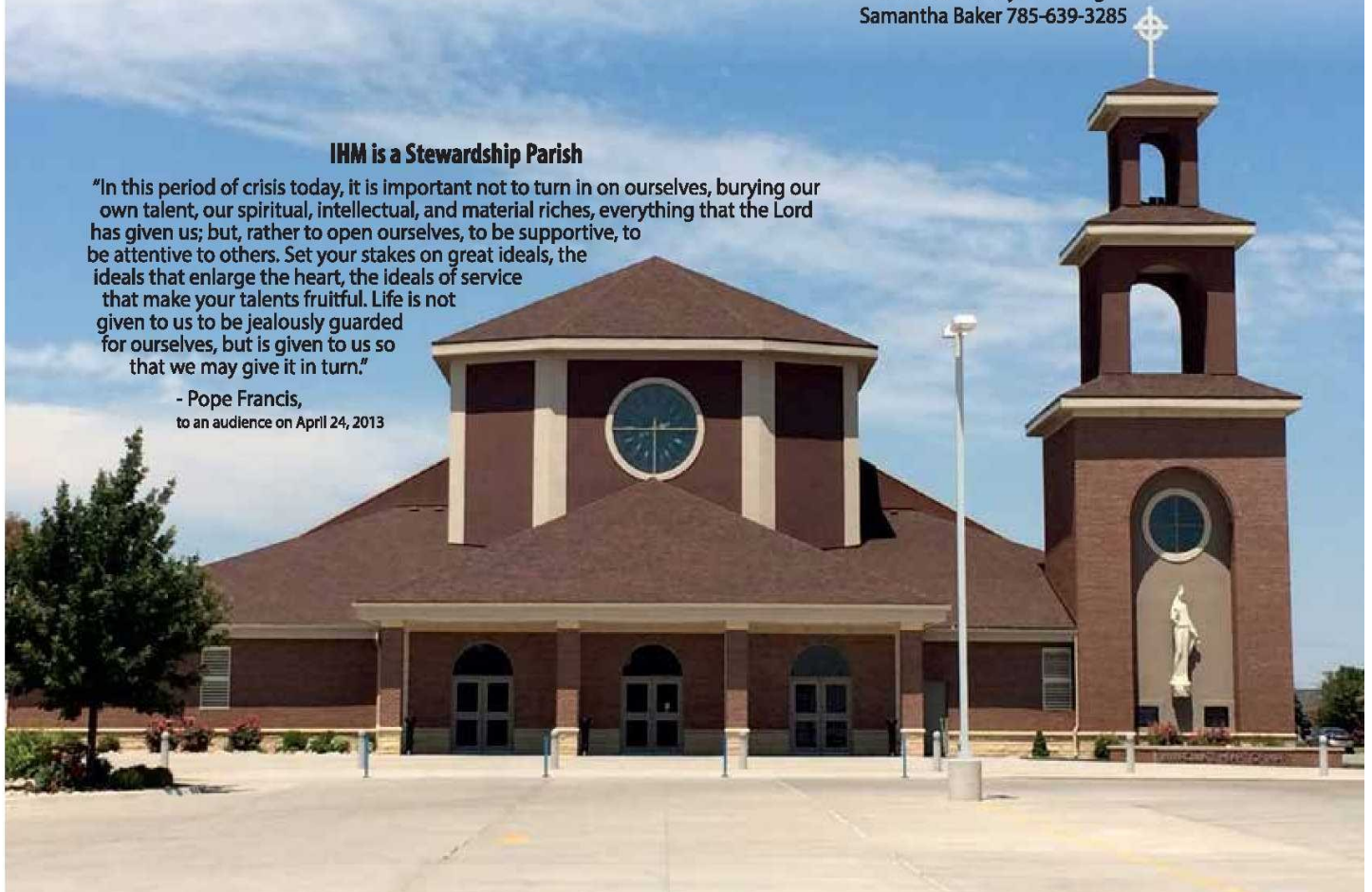

Parish Council Discernment Process



As we are approaching the end of the year, Parish Council will be looking for new members to fill the positions of those who have completed their terms of service. First, I would like to thank those members who have offered their time and talents to the Parish Council and to our parish. We very much appreciate all your work and service!

To replace our parish council members, we will be conducting a selection/discernment process. This will require the participation of the entire parish. This is how it works:

- 1) Each parish council member, as well as all parishioners, are asked to submit names/nominations of people who they see as qualified candidates to serve on Parish Council by contacting the parish office with your nomination.
- 2) At the next meeting, June 1st, Parish Council members are to pray about each nominated candidate, reflecting on his/her gifts and qualities. The members will then utilize a rating system to help determine which candidates would best serve the parish on Parish Council.
- 3) The pastor will then contact the chosen candidates, informing them of their being nominated and selected to serve Parish Council. The selected candidate will then be allowed to accept or decline this position as he/she desires.
