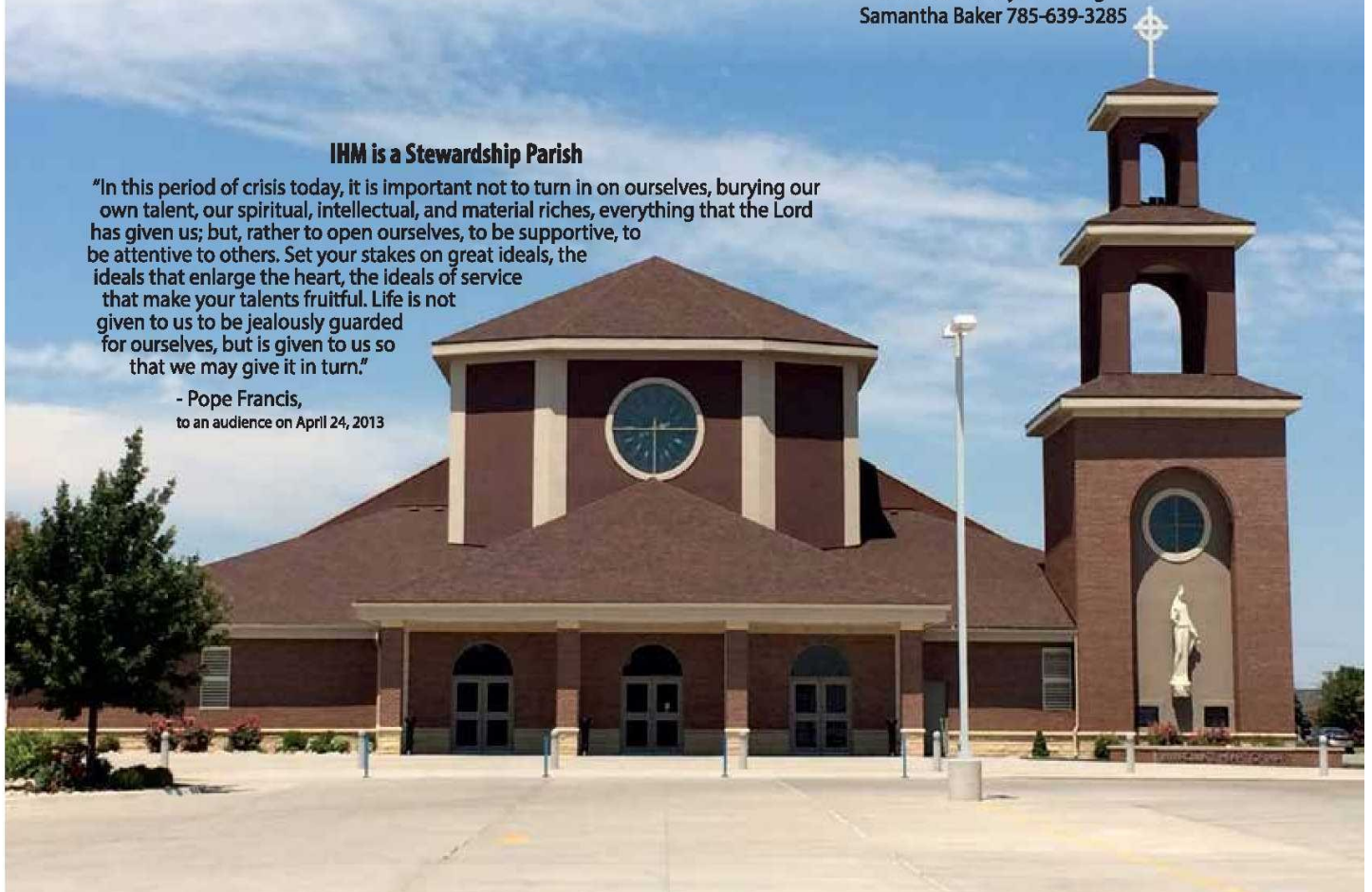

**Stewardship Reflection  
Pentecost Sunday**

ACTS 2:1-11; PS 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 COR 12:3b-7, 12-13; JN 20:19-23

Throughout our readings today for Pentecost Sunday, we see the powerful truth that the Holy Spirit gives us gifts and guidance in a deeply personal way. We are meant to use these gifts to build up the Body of Christ — each in our own unique way.

In our first reading from Acts, we hear of the dramatic outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. A strong driving wind filled the house, and tongues of fire came to rest on each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues.

Notice how personal this moment is. The Spirit came upon each individual, equipping them in a unique way to share the Gospel. The same is true for us today. Embracing the stewardship way of life means allowing the Holy Spirit to guide us in using the unique gifts He has given to each of us for the mission entrusted to us.

In our Gospel, Jesus sends His disciples forth: “As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” This is our mission as well. But we are not sent alone. Jesus gives us His peace — “Peace be with you.”

As this Easter season comes to a close, let us be at peace and resolve to rely more fully on the Holy Spirit as our guide through the stewardship way of life.

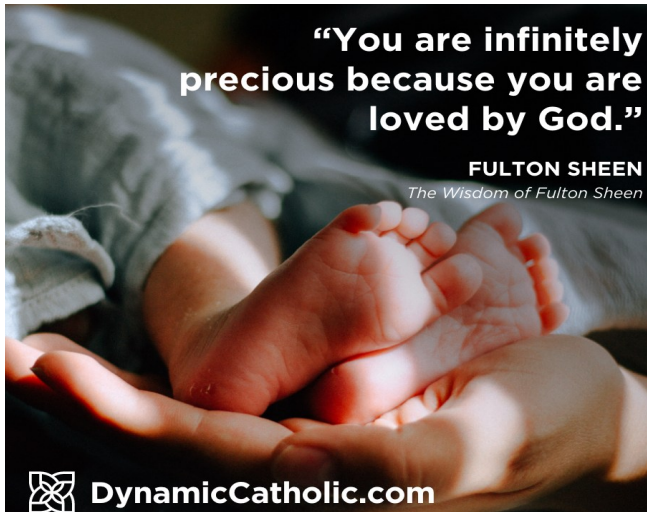

### Funeral Procession Etiquette—Keithley Funeral Homes

We've shared this before, but it's a reminder that is always worth repeating. During times of deep loss, a funeral procession is a solemn, final journey for a grieving family. Sadly, we often see drivers cutting through or failing to pull over. In reality, a procession usually takes just a few minutes to pass by. Yielding the right-of-way isn't just about traffic laws—it's a powerful act of community respect and empathy.

Here's how you can help:

- If You're Part of the Procession
  - ↳ Lights On: Turn on your headlights and hazard lights to clearly show your part of the group.
  - ↳ Stay Together: Maintain a close, consistent formation to keep the procession united.
  - ↳ Follow the Lead: Stick with the designated lead vehicle; the group often has the right-of-way.
- If You Encounter One
  - ↳ Yield with Kindness: If safe, pull over to the side of the road and stop to let the entire procession pass. It's a simple and greatly appreciated gesture of respect.
  - ↳ Be Patient: Processions move slowly. Give them the space and time they need without rushing.
  - ↳ Avoid Interference: It's best to avoid cutting into or passing a procession. This helps maintain their formation and shows consideration.
  - ↳ Teach the Next Generation: If you have new or young drivers in the household, please take a moment to share this etiquette with them.

Your patience and compassion truly support families during their difficult journey. Let's all drive with empathy.



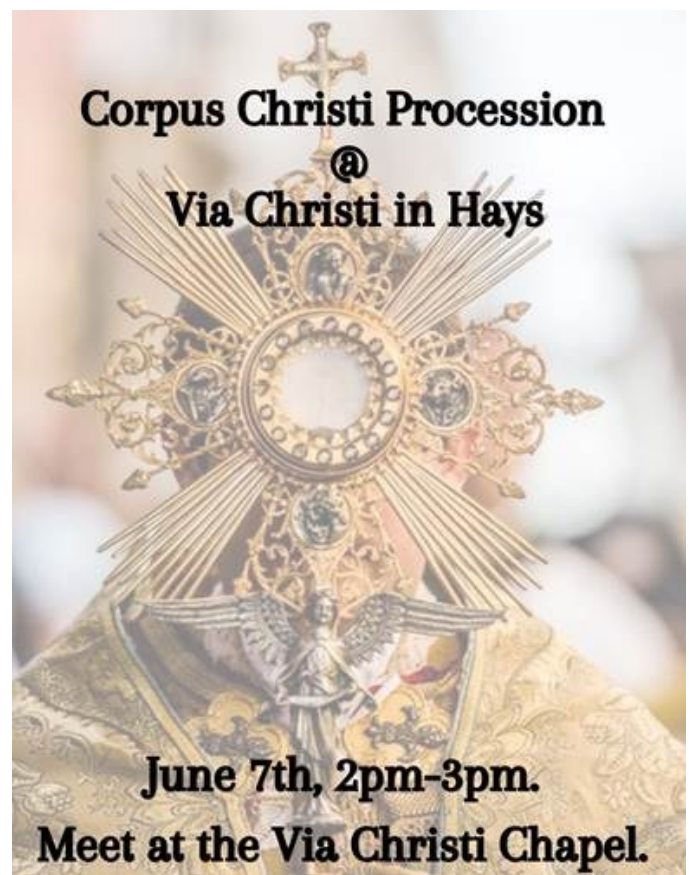

## DECREE

(Prot. No. GV 2026-021)

### Concerning the restored order of the Sacraments of Initiation for children

#### *In Nomine Domini*

Whereas, I have completed a time of prayer, discernment, and catechesis on the Sacraments of Initiation and the order for reception of the Sacraments of Initiation for children; and

Whereas, I have consulted with the Priests' Council, College of Consultors, Pastors, Directors of Religious Education, catechists, parents, and many others, to hear their support and concerns for the restored order. I now desire to move forward in hope of a renewed sacramental life in the diocese and a great outpouring of the Holy Spirit and the fullness of the graces of the Sacraments of Initiation.

Therefore, in virtue of the authority granted to me as Bishop of Salina, I hereby decree that beginning on the Solemnity of Pentecost, May 20, 2029, it will be the norm for this diocese that all baptized children who have completed the seventh year of age to receive the Sacraments of Confirmation together with First Eucharist.

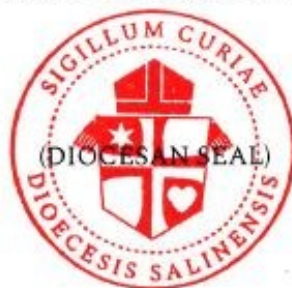
During the transition time beginning May 13, 2026, Pastors are to anticipate the adoption of the restored order and freely arrange for the reception of Confirmation and First Eucharist either in a combined way or separately at the time and age that they deem most beneficial to the children of their parishes.

Pastors are granted the faculty to Confirm in the territory they are assigned, provided that all necessary requirements are met for the valid and licit celebration, including proper preparation and proper notations are made in the sacramental records. The Pastor may associate with himself other presbyters for Confirmation; such presbyters, upon the Pastor's designation for specific celebrations only, are also granted the faculty to Confirm.

In addition, the four Deans are granted the faculty to Confirm at all the parishes within their deanery, at the request of the parish and with the permission of the local Pastor, during the transition period beginning May 13, 2026, provided the same requirements for proper sacramental celebration are met.

Beginning May 20, 2029, all celebrations of First Eucharist for baptized children must also include the celebration of Confirmation, and the diocesan bishop or his delegate(s) will preside at all parish celebrations in which Confirmation and First Eucharist are conferred.
