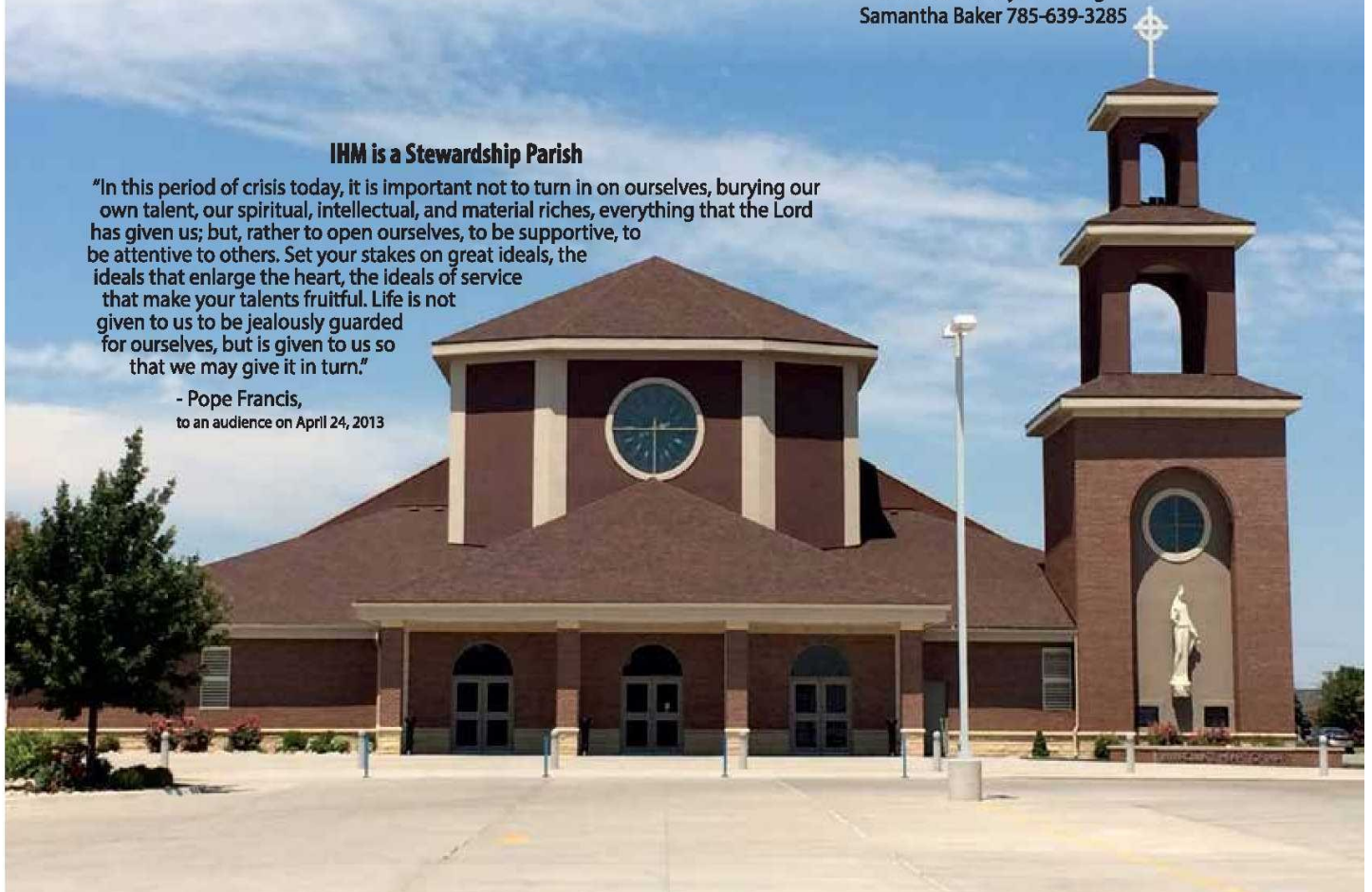

### Did You Know???

#### Extraordinary Homebound Ministers of Holy Communion

*Did you know that you do not have to volunteer as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion for Mass to be a volunteer minister to bring Communion to the homebound?*

Historically, the purpose of having Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion was not so that there would be more help at Mass, but rather so that there would be people to bring Communion to those who were unable to attend. It was only later, due to size of communities and lack of clergy, that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion were used at Mass as well.

For us at Immaculate Heart of Mary, we have many homebound parishioners who would like to receive Communion, and hence, we are often in need of extra volunteers to perform this ministry.

If you are interested in this ministry, please contact the parish office. Some minimal training will be required. You do not need to volunteer to help with Communion at Mass if you prefer; your willingness to help in this ministry is most appreciated!

#### Parish Hall and Facilities Rentals

*Did you know that the Parish Hall, as well as other rooms/spaces of the parish can be rented for events?*

At Immaculate Heart of Mary, we are blessed to offer several event spaces available to our parishioners and the greater Catholic community of Hays for a variety of gatherings and celebrations. Available spaces include the Parish Hall, Activity Center, Little Theater, and Hispanic Room.

In order for us to move toward restoring the order of the sacraments, we will transition in Fall 2026.


